

CAT PROGRESSION RULES

1. A candidate is allowed to undertake a maximum of four papers in single sitting .
2. A candidate is allowed to combine examination papers at different stages provided that the outstanding papers at lower stage are within the combination and provided
3. A candidate is allowed to combine Stage 1 and stage 2 provided that he/she does not violate rule number 1 and 2.
4. A candidate is allowed to combine subjects of stage 1 and those at stage 2 provided that he/she meets the following criteria.
 - a) A candidate who has not yet passed S1.1 will not be allowed to attempt S2.1
 - b) A candidate who has not yet passed S1.2 will not be allowed to attempt S2.2
 - c) A candidate who has not yet passed S1.3 will not be allowed to attempt S2.3
5. A candidate is allowed to combine subjects of stage 2 and those at stage 3 provided that he/she meets the following criteria.
 - a) A candidate who has not yet passed S2.2 will not be allowed to attempt S3.2
 - b) A candidate who has not yet passed S2.1 will not be allowed to attempt S3.1
6. A candidate is allowed to combine subjects of advanced levels provided that there are no outstanding papers at lower levels and rule 2 is not applicable.
7. A candidate will not be allowed to attempt stage 3 papers with outstanding papers at stage 1
8. A candidate shall be allowed to attempt the option papers/subjects if he/she has passed stage 1, stage 2 and at least one paper at stage 3
